

Regina Lawn Bowling Club Protocols for Return to Play

FORMS

There are three forms to be completed. All forms will be maintained at the club for future reference.

- 1) **RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT –**
This form must be completed once before the first time a member bowls.
This form is for insurance purposes because the Bowls Sask insurer has instituted a COVID-19 exclusion clause in their insurance policy.
- 2) **Declaration of Compliance – COVID-19**
This form must be completed once before the first time a member bowls.
It is to ensure you understand the risks of COVID-19 and how to comply.
- 3) **COVID-19 Fit to Play Questionnaire**
This form must be completed daily each time a member comes to the club.
It must be presented to the Safety Officer before entering the facility.

A fourth form is required for anyone under the age of majority.

- 4) **INFORMED CONSENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT**
This form is completed by a parent or guardian for members under the age of majority and is only completed once before the first time a member bowls.

SAFETY OFFICER

This person is the one who is collecting and storing the forms. One of our summer students, Isaac Tamlin, will be fulfilling this role when he is at the club. If he is not at the club during one of the times bowling is allowed, the first person to arrive will be his designate and will be required to collect the daily Fit to Play forms and put them on the desk for Isaac to file. It should be noted that someone must fulfil this role and since Isaac will not be there all the time, the member who arrives first must step forward and fulfil this role, otherwise no bowling. The designate can still bowl once all Fit to Play forms have been collected and placed on the desk.

BOWLING TIMES

Bowling will be allowed at three specific times each day - 10am, 2pm and 7pm. These are the times the Safety Officer or the designate will be available to collect the daily Fit to Play form. Do not arrive more than 10 minutes before the scheduled start times. Members must physically distance at the entrance. Members must leave the facility immediately after their game ends.

Only 30 people, including workers, will be allowed in the facility at the same time.

SIGNS

The City has posted a sign at the entrance to indicate some of the restrictions. Other signs are posted in the clubhouse showing how to sanitize the washroom after use. Sanitizing solutions will be available. There is also a sign showing symptoms of COVID-19.

CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse is open but restricted. You enter through the east door and exit through the door onto the deck.

Only one washroom is available for use.

The kitchen area and lockers are roped and are unavailable for use.

High touch areas will be sanitized frequently.

Garbage

It is recommended that you should bring a plastic bag with you to take home all your personal garbage.

BOWLING RULES

- Each person will bring their own bowls each time they come. If they do own their own bowls, a set of bowls will be assigned to them for the duration of time that we are restricted. They will take the bowls home with them.

- Do not shake hands before or after games. Acknowledge your opponent in some other way.
- Only singles and pairs games will be allowed. Individual practicing by a member will also be allowed.
- Games will be played on alternating rinks - one rink used, the next rink will be vacant, another rink used, etc. This is to enforce physical distancing.
- No mats, rakes or scorecards will be allowed. Personal towels will be used in place of mats. In a singles or pairs game, have one person always set their personal towel for each end.
- One person on each rink will set the jack. There is no need to throw the jack. Jacks will be sanitized after each game.
- The players must only touch their own bowls during the games.
- If a measure is required use your fingers to decide, do not use a measuring tool.
- Rink markers will be set up for each scheduled time. Leave the rink markers up after completing your game.
- If groundsheets are required on the greens, they will be set up and taken down by Isaac.
